# Here's how we're preventing the spread...

Dear Winners' Academy Families,

We have all experienced extremely different and most difficult unprecedented times with the global pandemic. Never in our lifetime have we had to adapt to a situation that caused devastating disruption to our lives. As adults we have life's experiences to fall back on to assist us with trying to cope with this situation. Children on the other hand, have not lived long enough to be able to reach deep into their psyche and get strength from their past life experiences to deal with what was thrust in front of them. For these reasons it is more important than ever before to stop and take pause to realize that children need to get back to some normalcy in order to regain their balance in life as they knew it to be. Now our summer Art camp is opening, children can reunite with the exciting times they remembered and socialize with their friends. The structure of our exciting activity schedule along with the awesome special events will help them rejuvenate their spirit of life and be able to be kids once again.

As we prepare for our summer program, Health & Safety has always been one of our core values. At Winners' Academy We understand the severity of this Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) crisis and have been going above and beyond our existing protocols to maintain the cleanliness of our facility. In addition to that, here is an outline of some of the actions we will take beginning Monday, July 6, 2020.

- Safe distancing of 6 feet or more must be adhered to during drop off & pick-up procedures. Staff, parents and visitors must not congregate within the first floor hallways or the building entrance, walkways, or sidewalks.
- Families will limit drop-off/pick-up parent/guardian to 1 person at a time per family
- Staff, parents and visitors will not use first floor bathrooms. Bathrooms will be roped off during regular weekday operations or signage will be placed on doors for restricting use/access.
- Staff, parents, and visitors will not walk through other parts of the building, other than the direct path of travel from the side entry doors to the daycare entry doors.
- All children will have daily health checks conducted during drop-off. This means that teachers will be asking you questions about your child and taking their temperatures. Any child with a temperature of 100.4°F or higher, or with COVID-19 symptoms will not be permitted to enter the facility and may not return without a doctor's note.
- All staff, parents, and visitors entering the building will have their temperatures checked every day and will not be permitted to enter any classroom with COVID-19 symptoms.
- In accordance with the Centers for Disease Control, we will limit the size of our classroom groups to ten or fewer children until further notice.
- All staff and children will wash their hands immediately upon arrival and approximately every 2 hours throughout the day.
- If we must close due to someone testing positive for COVID-19, we will be notified by the DOH and we will keep an open line of communication with families regarding self-quarantine procedures and when we would be re-opening our doors.
- We are restricting child personal belongings and bags coming into the program.
- As per our NYS Forward Safety Plan, we are documenting our cleaning procedures multiple times per day.

- Upon notification that a child or staff member who has been on our facility within the previous 7 days is tested positive, we will close for a period of 3 days to:
  - Keep everyone off the property for 24 hours to let any infected droplets from the person testing positive "settle" [as guided by the CDC](#). We will also inform everyone who would have come into close contact with that person that they should take the recommended precautionary self-quarantine and will not be allowed back into the building until the recommended quarantine period has ended.
  - On day 2, we will go in to clean and disinfect the premises.
  - We will remain closed for a third day just as a precautionary measure to keep all children out of the building for 72 hours. Children and staff who were not in close contact with the person testing positive will be permitted to return to the center after the 3-day closure.
- All staff members will wear a mask on-site each day.
- Parents may choose to have their children wear a mask if their child is 2 years of age or older and free from respiratory issues.

We hope to see you and your little ones very soon. We will continue to keep you informed as updates occur!
